Circular shape girna with either a roofed enclosure or a field room built as an extension to it. The hut is currently closed by a wooden door. The entrance faces south and it has a small window on its western wall and another one on its northern wall . The rubble walls in the area are in a very good condition some of which have water channels. In close proximity there is an irregularly shaped depression in the rock surface. Probably it was a natural depression that was enlarged to hold water. British period backs were noticed lying around in the area.

Although it is locked Fsadni (1999: 87) describes the hut since it was forced open when he was recording the hut. According to him it was inhabited for a long time.




