

The outbuilding lies at the entrance and has a stone bench at the back. Facing it is the entrance to 2 rooms which are roofed with 'xorok' and a wooden beam. The door to the 2nd room lies on the northern wall of the 1st. Both entrances have a flat lintel on the exterior and an arch on the interior. The 2nd room also has an arch supporting the ceiling. The walls are pierced by a number of windows and cupboard in the thickness of the wall.

Some of the rooms were divided at a later stage using rouch upper globigerina limestone blocks. Part of the building is unaccessable.






